Charles Parker was a pioneering documentary radio producer who worked for the BBC in Birmingham from 1954-1972. He made the groundbreaking Radio Ballads with Ewan McColl and Peggy Seeger, devoted his life to activities which recorded lives that would otherwise have gone unrecorded and promoted the enormous cultural value of language used in everyday conversations. At his death in 1980 he left a huge archive illustrating all aspects of his life and work including over 4,500 recordings of speech and music on reel-to-reel tapes. A Trust was set up to preserve the material and to make it available to the public. In conjunction with the Library of Birmingham it has provided storage of the collection, raised funds for digitisation of the tapes and published an online catalogue. The Trust also runs the annual Charles Parker Day and a well-regarded competition for radio students.
